Official Rules

- Please note that all decisions made by judges are final. The official rules are intended as a guideline for spectators and participants.
- Contestants must report to the main stage 10 minutes before the contest is to begin.
- All specifications on food products are give in the schedule.
- Contestants will be allowed to drink water as needed during contest, with the exception of the watermelon contest.
- Contestants will be allowed to use their hands on all products with the exception of watermelon; a spoon will be given for the ice cream. Watermelon contest requires that both hands be held behind your back until finished.
- Contestants must remain in their seat, to signal to the judges you are done stand and raise your hands.
- Visible signs of sickness may result in disqualification.
- The first to finish the given amount of food or the contestant with the least amount left at the end of five minutes will be the winner.
- In the event of a tie an eat off will be held.

Prize

A prize of \$10 will be awarded to the winner after the judges make their final decision.
