**Ribbons Awarded in Following Classes:**

**1. Pullets 2. Hens 3. Cockerels 4. Cock Birds**

1. Entry Fee: \$1 per head per class. All pair or pen entries are treated as 1 entry.
2. Only clean, healthy, and free-of-disease birds will be accepted.
3. All birds & rabbits must be entered by 3pm Saturday, Aug 6 & will remain on exhibit until 5p on Tuesday, Aug 9 or forfeit all premiums.
4. All birds will be shown in pens or singles.
5. Singles consist of 1 Cockerel or 1 Pullet. Pens consist of 1 Cockerel & 2 pullets or 3 pullets.
6. Rabbits will only be shown in singles.
7. All birds must be the bona-fide property of exhibitor.
8. All poultry will be judged on the American Poultry Association Rules.
9. All birds tested Sunday, Aug 7 by state inspector unless exhibitor has proper NPIP paperwork.
10. Pre-registration is STRONGLY encouraged at [info@putnamcountyfair.org](mailto:info@putnamcountyfair.org) to avoid waiting to coop-in. Entry forms are available online and on page 39 of this book.

5. American Class ((Barred) Plymouth Rocks, Dominiques, Wyandottes, Rhode Island Reds, Buckeyes, Jersey Giants, & New Hampshires) – cock, cockerel, hen, pullet.

4. Rose Comb Clean Leg (Belgian Bearded d'Anvers, Dominiques, Rosecombs, Seabrights, & Wyandottes)
5. Single Comb Clean Leg (Australorps, Dutch, Japanese, Leghorns, Rhode Island Reds, Orpingtons, Plymouth Rocks, & Sussex)
