



**COVID 19 Protocols for the Fairest of Fair Pageants of the 95th Putnam
County Agricultural & Industrial Fair
Saturday, July 17, 2021 – Cookeville Community Center
240 Carlen Ave., Cookeville, TN 38501**

To keep everyone as safe as possible, the following COVID protocols must be followed by all contestants, their relatives, guests, and spectators. Failure to follow any of these will result in you being asked to leave the pageant.

- Please do not attend the event – If any guest/participant has been exposed to COVID19 in the past 10 days; If any guest/participant currently has symptoms of COVID19; or If any guest/participant has been positive for COVID19 in the past 10 days.
- Anyone who does not want to follow these guidelines is invited to watch the event on Facebook Live Stream from the Putnam County Fairest of the Fair Facebook page.
- Seating will be limited. When available seating is "sold out" we will not be able to allow additional guests and spectators into the building.
- Admission is \$10 per person, and good for the pageant which you are there to see (11am Children's Pageant; 2pm Mrs./Ms. Pageant; 4pm Youth pageant; or the 7pm Fairest of the Fair Pageant). The building will be cleared between pageants.
- Masks must be worn over your nose and mouth by all spectators over the age of 2. No exceptions.
- All seating will be in groups of 5 and spaced following social distancing guidelines. Chairs on the floor are not to be moved. Tape on theater seating is not to be removed. For these reasons we encourage contestants to limit their spectators to five or fewer people in person and to encourage others to watch from home via the Livestream.
- All adults on stage with contestants ages 0-5 must wear a mask.
- During the Friday night practice session (practice is for ages 9 and up only) only one person will be allowed with each contestant and must remain in the theater seating area and everyone must wear a mask to participate.
- Any lines for entry, and for bathrooms or concessions will practice social distancing of at least six feet.
- The Putnam County Fair follows the recommendations of the CDC and the Putnam County Health Department.
